FULLY FUND THE 2024-2025 DIVISION OF ARTS & CULTURE GRANTS

Every year, cultural organizations from around the state submit grant requests in four categories to the Florida Division of Arts & Culture. These requests are vetted and scored through a rigorous process, including a live panel review. All grants must be matched dollar-for-dollar by the organization, and twice annual reporting is required. This process happens every year, and every year, funding must be allocated during the legislative session.

This year, the Division has recommended funding **864 grants across the state** at a total investment of **\$77 million** in the 2024/2025 budget. This is a banner year with nearly 100 more grant recommendations than last year (many being first-time requests) and \$10 million more in funding.

Among the total request, there are 66 grants recommended in Palm Beach County for a total of \$7.6 million—nearly 10% of the full funding request.

Last year, the grant program was funded at \$43.2 million (full request was \$68 million). We need bi-partisan leadership during the legislative session to help us grow funding levels this year. Funding partnerships are **critical to a nonprofit's sustainability** and the **community's access to the arts**.

The Cultural Council for Palm Beach County and its Cultural Advocacy Alliance recommends full funding of all projects.

In addition to the Arts & Culture Grants, the Cultural Council is committed to promoting Palm Beach County as a cultural tourism destination and growing the industry in Florida.

- Support non-restrictive funding for VISIT FLORIDA to ensure Florida continues to be top of mind as a leading vacation and meeting destination.
- Oppose adding any additional uses for Tourist Development Tax (TDT) revenues.
 Any new uses will diminish the effectiveness of these dollars, which were established for the promotion and marketing of tourism.
